

Professional License Reciprocity Disclosure

The Salon Professional Academy will provide programs of study that meet the minimum curriculum requirements as prescribed by the State of Wisconsin.

For states outside of Wisconsin, The Academy has not made a determination on whether the programs meet other states' educational/licensure requirements.

The Salon Professional Academy does not provide training activities out-of-state. All programs offered at The Academy lead to professional licensure in the State of Wisconsin. All students, including those who live in bordering states, are notified prior to enrollment that the education received at The Salon Professional Academy follows the State of Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services regulations which requires minimally 1550 hours for Cosmetology, 450 hours for Esthetics, and 600 hours for Massage Therapy. The Academy's programs exceed these requirements as follows: 1800 hours for Cosmetology, 600 hours for Esthetics, and 750 hours for Massage Therapy.

The Academy recommends that all applicants and students familiarize themselves with the comparison of other states' regulations and hours required for licensure as applicable.

Students are required to complete all practical on campus as The Academy does not enroll strictly distance students who reside in other states.

Additionally, the Transfer Policy indicates: "After careful examination of the student's academic records and placement test results, the Director of Education will determine, at her discretion, how many transfer hours The Salon Professional Academy will accept and where to place the student in the program." The Academy's curriculum has not been reviewed for compliance with other states' professional licensure requirements, and per the policy in the Student Handbook, The Salon Professional Academy cannot guarantee the transferability of any particular courses.
